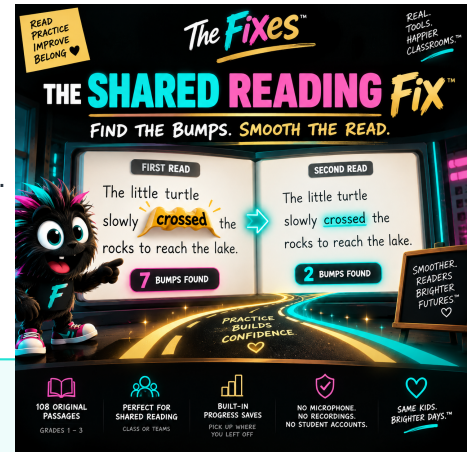

## WHAT IT IS

A shared-reading practice tool for Grades 1-3. The teacher starts an original passage and taps any word that causes a stumble, hesitation, skip, or pronunciation problem. The tapped word rises into a visual bump.

The class then practices each bump as a **word, phrase, and sentence**, rereads the full passage, and sees how many bumps were smoothed on the second read.

**Nothing is listening. There is no microphone, recording, speech recognition, student account, or required student name.**



## THE 4-STEP LOOP

### 1. READ

Choose Grade 1, 2, or 3, pick a passage, choose Whole Class or a team, and start the first read. The timer counts up so the teacher does not have to race the class.

### 2. FIND THE BUMPS

Tap the exact word when the reading gets bumpy. Tap it again to undo. The goal is quick teacher judgment, not complicated error coding.

### 3. SMOOTH THE BUMPS

After the first read, every marked word gets three short reps: word, phrase, sentence. Complete the reps and flatten the bump.

### 4. READ AGAIN

The passage returns clean for a fresh second read. Mark only the bumps you hear this time. The final screen celebrates improvement.

# TEACHER NOTES

Simple enough to use tomorrow. Useful enough to keep all year.

## WHAT COUNTS AS A BUMP?

Use your professional judgment. A bump can be a word the reader misreads, skips, struggles to pronounce, or pauses on long enough that it breaks the flow. If a reader immediately self-corrects and you do not want it counted, tap the word again to remove it.

## TIME IS INFORMATION, NOT THE PRIZE

The screen tracks elapsed time, but the large student-facing result is **bumps smoothed**. This keeps the emotional focus on improvement rather than public speed rankings.

## SHARED READING OPTIONS

Use Whole Class, a small group, or one of the colour-team labels. Readers can alternate by sentence or paragraph, read chorally, echo read, or take turns. The software does not force one instructional routine.

## ORIGINAL-CONTENT NOTE

**All 108 passages in this package were written specifically for this product. The file does not include excerpts from commercial readers, published classroom programs, or third-party passage libraries. The instructional ideas of guided oral reading, teacher feedback, practice, and rereading are presented through an original interface, visual bump mechanic, repair loop, artwork, and code.**

## YEAR-LONG LIBRARY

The file contains **108 original passages**: 36 each for Grades 1, 2, and 3. The library is divided into Launch, Build, and Stretch sections so teachers can move through the school year without uploading text.

## BROWSER PROGRESS

Completed passages and best improvement save with local browser storage on the same device. Teacher Settings includes **Backup Progress** and **Restore Backup** so progress can be moved without creating an account.

## PRIVACY + ASSESSMENT BOUNDARY

No student audio or personal profile is stored. Results are teacher-marked practice observations, not a standardized running record, diagnostic result, or replacement for formal reading assessment.

Quick start: Open the HTML file in a modern browser, project it, choose a grade and passage, and begin. For the cleanest classroom view, use Fullscreen.

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
