

THE WHISPER FIX™

Party Mode

A classroom party where whispering is the whole game.

QUIET FUN

What it is

A zero-prep projected classroom experience designed to make quiet feel like the event — not the punishment.

Core idea

Most of the session is calm free whisper time. The screen adds just enough atmosphere, surprise scans and tiny missions to keep kids bought in while the teacher gets a genuine breather.

The Whisper Scan is pretend. No microphone, camera or student data is used.



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HOW TO RUN IT

1. Choose a party length

Pick 5, 10 or 15 minutes. Ten minutes is the default and the sweet spot for a quick classroom reset or indoor-recess breather.

2. Set the only rule

Kids may talk, laugh, draw, build, play cards or do whatever quiet activity you allow — but voices stay at whisper level.

3. Press Start Party Mode

No teacher narration is required. The timer, party atmosphere, scans, secret missions and ending run on their own.

WHAT THE SCREEN DOES

Free whisper time — Slow party lights, soft colour washes, drifting confetti and the main countdown. Most of the party lives here.

Whisper Scan — A 5-second warning gives the room time to settle. Then the scan sweeps left, centre and right before revealing the result.

Fake-out scan — It still performs a complete scan. The joke only lands after the class believes the scan is real.

Secret missions — Occasional tiny prompts add humour and novelty without turning the party into another teacher-led activity.

Super-Secret Mode — A brief ultra-quiet challenge resets the room if energy starts creeping upward.

Last call — The final minute tells kids the party is ending without suddenly re-energizing the room.

Curtain finale — At 0:00 the lights settle, curtains close, and the screen fades to black. Voices stay quiet until the teacher releases them.

TEACHER NOTES

BEST TIMES TO USE IT

- Indoor recess
- Ten unexpected minutes
- End-of-day decompression
- After a high-energy block
- Friday / assembly-day gaps
- A quiet reward that stays quiet

WHY THE SCAN WORKS

It is theatre, not surveillance. The 5-second warning creates just enough anticipation for kids to self-correct their volume. The sweep keeps them watching. The occasional fake-out keeps it funny. Because no microphone is used, the experience stays simple, private and predictable for the teacher.

WHAT THE TEACHER DOES

- Set the allowed quiet activities
- Start the party
- Pause if needed
- End early if needed
- Use Fullscreen for projection
- Release normal voices after the finale

DESIGN RULE

The screen occasionally threatens the party. It never becomes the party.

Don't ask them to be quiet. Give them a reason to want to be quiet.
